Dear Friends

Assalamu Alaikum!

It is a matter of immense pleasure to present before you a brief annual report of Aligarh Bachchon Ka Ghar for the session 2015-2016 for your kind perusal and that of kind well-wishers, sympathizers and donors. We sincerely solicit valuable feedback, advices, suggestions and co-operation in the furtherance of its effective functioning from all.

As you all know and as we have mentioned in our earlier reports, Aligarh being the seat of learning in the form of Aligarh Muslim University and having a conducive atmosphere for the establishment of a model orphanage, Aligarh Childrens Home (ABKG) was established and registered as a TRUST in March, 2001 at Aligarh for cherishing the dreams of a comprehensive welfare of orphans with the following aims and objectives:

- a) *Total support and adoption of children for complete modern education and upbringing with a view to develop responsible, God fearing and worthy Indian citizens.*
- b) *To impart social, moral and Islamic cultural education.*
- c) *To develop team network, self-reliance and competitive sprit among the children.*
- d) *Dedication to the cause of orphans and destitute.*
- e) *To save the children from forced labour, illiteracy, beggary and deprivation.*

The sponsorship and care of orphans could be achieved as a result of combined, collective and cumulative efforts of all our well-wishers and by the Grace of Allah; we are now in the sixteenth year of our establishment and have completed another eventful session of 2015-16.

School Programs:

Aligarh Bachchon Ka Ghar (ABKG) is sponsoring our Children in various reputed English Medium Public Schools mainly The Sana School, Al-Barkat Public School, Ayesha Tarin Modern Public School, Iqra Public School, Aligarh Modern School, R. K. Model School, Al-Hira Public School, Cambridge Public School. The children's response was very positive and they have fully adjusted themselves to the New Campus environment where they were shifted in 2007-08. They are not only doing good in examinations securing high percentage of marks during the preceding academic sessions but also attracted the appreciation of the teachers and elders. Examination results for the session 2015-16 may be seen in the attachment. We feel extremely glad to mention here that three students of ABKG appeared at Secondary School Examination (CBSE) this year and passed with high scores all in 1st Division one of them topped in Aligarh Modern School. They had appeared at the Entrance Test for Admissions in class XI from Aligarh Muslim University. We congratulate them and appreciate the teachers who guided them to this success. Alhamdulillah!

Annual Function:

This year Annual Function of ABKG will be held independently after Ramadaan in the University area to acquaint more people.

Total Sponsorship of the Children:

All the children were provided with Eid ul Adha clothes last year Dr. Mazhar Kazi, USA and is the same may be for this year and normal clothes; school uniform, school books, school fees, food and lodging, medical facilities and all items of daily requirements will be provided as per our distinguish. The number of our adopted children went upto 80. But we are sponsoring a good number of orphans undertaken by some good schools in Bihar and West Bengal in particular.

Extra Curricular Activities:

The children were provided with complete sets of indoor and outdoor sports equipments. They were also encouraged to participate in inter-house and inter-school sports competition. Regular games timings have been included in the day-to-day routine. A good number of guests also visit ABKG.

Sports & Games:

This is a regular program of ABKG and all our children play at the same time in various games including Football and Athletics under the supervision of a full-fledged Physical Instructor and his team.

Educational Tour:

Educational Tour was planned and executed in the month of January. Children visited important location of western states of India. Mr. Abdul Mannan and Mr. Mustafa Bilgrami escorted them during educational tour of Maharashtra and Gujarat.

Children Library:

The existing Children's Library and reading room has been improved so as to enable the students to acquire more knowledge on Islamic history, cultural, moral education, general knowledge and development of their reading habits under overall supervision of the Staff.

Health Care:

Members of the Faculty of Medicine, J. N. Medical College, Community Medicine and doctors of the District hospital visited the Aligarh Bachchon Ka Ghar regularly. Children have been vaccinated against Hepatitis 'B', Polio and other diseases. We have also opened MET Clinic in the campus and new medical facilities have been planned here and specialist doctors have offered their services for the localities which our inmates will also avail.

Follow Up of Last Year's Programs

Hostel Building and Mosque have been painted as planned. The campus was beautified by further improving the vicinity, facilities and environment. About 400 poor children have been given educational expenses during the period.

Financial Crises:

We have been facing financial crises since as always we have to beg from pillar to post. We have already mentioned that we had to drop adoption of girls orphans and cut the number of children from 100 to 80 because of this reason. The financial crises are getting more acute. We are trying our best to improve the situation. We hope and pray that by the grace of Allah Subhanhu wa Ta'ala and generous cooperation and support by our sponsors, sympathizers and you all we will come out of the situation and achieve our target. Moreover the girls section may start functioning from the this session, Inshallah.

We pray to Allah Subhanahu wa Ta'ala to guide and help us and bless us with success. We seek support and co-operation from all sponsors and well-wishers. May Allah bless them with His choicest rewards here and hereafter. Ameen!

USA & UK Trip of Mr. Mozaffar Ali

“Mr. Mozaffar Ali, Gen. Secretary of ABKG will start from Delhi on 23rd April and reach London (UK). On 1st May he will reach Washington DC (USA), From 1st May onwards he is expected to visit New Jersey, Atlanta, New York, Chicago and finally attend the ICNA Convention in Baltimore on 28-30 May and will be there up to 1st June, insha Allah. During his trip, he will also explore cooperation and support for our orphan care program of Aligarh Bachchon Ka Ghar (ABKG). At present ABKG is accommodating about 100 orphan children in its hostel. There are many applications for new admission which are pending for lack of accommodation capacity in hostel. Construction of a few new rooms in the hostel is urgently needed. Construction of a 600 sq. ft. room costs US\$. 13,335/- + (I.Rs.800,100/-). Also, sponsorships for children are urgently needed. Sponsorship of a child is US\$. 833.33/- + (I.Rs. 50,000/-) per annum. Your kind cooperation and support is earnestly solicited. Kindly cooperate with Mr. Mozaffar Ali in this matter during his trip. Jazakumullahu khair.”
